**Abstract:**

Women and Climate Change – two Sides of the Coin. It is well established that men and women experience and are affected by climate change differently. Women generally are more exposed to the effects of floods, droughts, and other climate related shocks, while having less access to means of coping with them. For example, women and children are 1.4 times more likely than men to die during a natural disaster, and women constitute 80 percent of people displaced by climate change (FAO & ARC, 2021). Emphasizing the urgent need to view women not merely as victims of climate impacts, but as agents of change in adaptation efforts. In conclusion, empowering women in the field of climate change adaptation, as in many other developmental fields, means to multiply the impacts of interventions and investments and must therefore play a front-and-center role – for community health nursing, companies, funders, intermediaries, and other ecosystem players alike. This way, we can not only tackle the climate crisis in a more targeted way, but also foster a more inclusive and sustainable future for all.
